The approval granted by coverage under the General Permit is subject to the following conditions, in addition to those in the General Permit:

1. The project sponsor shall comply with the terms and conditions of the General Permit for groundwater remediation for all groundwater withdrawals and the consumptive use of that water.
2. If a conflict exists between the requirements in the Notice of Intent (NOI) or its supporting documents and the terms and conditions of the General Permit, the terms and conditions of the General Permit shall prevail.
3. The project sponsor's failure to comply with the terms or conditions of the General Permit or operation that is determined to be inconsistent with the NOI is grounds for the Commission to take enforcement action pursuant to 18 C.F.R. Part 808, and/or to revoke coverage under this General Permit, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 806.17.
4. This project is approved for inclusion in the Commission's Comprehensive Plan for the Water Resources of the Susquehanna River Basin.
5. The metering description and consumptive use calculation method submitted with the NOI is approved and made a part of this approval.
6. The project sponsor shall keep daily records of the project's combined withdrawal, and shall report the data to the Commission quarterly, and as otherwise required, in the form and manner as prescribed by Commission staff. Quarterly monitoring reports shall be submitted online and are due within thirty (30) days after the close of the preceding quarter. Any alternative measuring, monitoring, or accounting procedure shall be submitted for review and approval by Commission staff in accordance with 18 C.F.R. § 806.30. Modifications shall not be made until the project sponsor receives written approval of the amended plan. All data collected and submitted as required under this approval shall be maintained by the project sponsor for the duration of the approval.

This Approval for Coverage under GP-01 is issued by the Executive Director pursuant to the authority set forth in 18 C.F.R. § 806.17(c)(4).
