RE: SAFE HARBOR WATER POWER CORPORATION – 2025 FISH PASSAGE REPORT

Dear Ms. Eyer, Mr. Williamson, and Resource Agencies:

Safe Harbor Water Power Corporation (Brookfield) is hereby submitting the 2025 Safe Harbor Fish Passage Report for the Safe Harbor Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1025, NATDAM NO. PA00855) in Lancaster County, PA.

The Safe Harbor fish lift operates from mid-April to mid-June each year. It typically commences operation shortly after the Holtwood Fish Lift passes approximately 500 American Shad into Lake Aldred and stops a day or two after the Holtwood lift shuts down for the season.

Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) and US Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS), submitted written requests to Brookfield on December 13, 2024 asking that the Safe Harbor fish lift not be operated in 2025 in an effort to limit the expansion of invasive species. This was based on the recommendation from multiple resource agencies.

Brookfield filed notification with FERC on June 25, 2025 noting the suspension of fish passage.

SRAFRC has now formed Steering and Technical Committees to begin the process of facilitating implementation of the invasive species plan. These groups meet monthly to discuss invasive species management and any new technologies available to aide the process.

Maintenance and repairs will be performed on the fish lift as they are needed moving forward. Since the lift did not operate in 2025, there is no fish passage report enclosed.
