The Susquehanna River Basin Commission (Commission) has reviewed the permit modification order request for Water Allocation Permit No. WA 36-799A and the permit Modification Order No. 1 issued to the Borough of Akron on October 18, 2016, by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP). The Commission concurs with the October 18, 2016, Modification Order No.1 as approved and conditioned by PADEP. Pursuant to Commission Regulation 18 CFR § 806.7 and the Memorandum of Understanding between the Commission and PADEP, this permit will also serve as your approval from the Commission under Commission Regulation 18 CFR Part 806, and is identified as Commission Docket No. 20180310.

Pursuant to Commission Regulation 18 CFR § 808.2 relating to administrative appeals, an appeal to this action must be made to the Commission within thirty (30) days of receipt of this notice. All appeals must be made in writing on the Commission's Notice of Appeal form and conform to the requirements of Commission Regulation 18 CFR § 808.2. Pursuant to Commission Regulation 18 CFR § 808.2(i), an appeal made under this section stays the commencement of the ninety (90)-day appeal period contained in Section 3.10(6) of the Susquehanna River Basin Compact.
