Rich Valley Golf Inc is requesting the RENEWAL of SRBC Application #19990306, which authorized the Surface-Water Withdrawal (30 day average) of .325 mgd from Conodoguinet Creek and Consumptive Water Use of up to .325 mgd for Golf Course Irrigation.

FACILTY NAME. Rich Valley Golf Course

LONG TERM OWNER/OPERATOR: Rich Valley Golf, Inc.

LOCATION. The site/facility is located along Rich Valley Road in Silver Spring Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. The location of the surface water withdrawal is a point on the west bank of the Conodoguinet Creek, approximately 150 feet upstream of the southbound lane crossing of Interstate Route 81.

PURPOSE. The purpose of the application is to request approval for the continued surface-water withdrawal and consumptive use of water for irrigation of fairways, greens and tees at a 21-hole golf course and driving range.

START OF OPERATIONS. September 01, 2001

PROJECT FEATURES. We are requesting a continued approval for the surface-water withdrawal of up to .325 million gallons per day (mgd) and consumptive use of surface-water of up to 0.325 mgd for the irrigation of greens, fairways and tee boxes at our 21-hole golf course facility and driving range. Water requirements for the golf course facility were determined from calculated irrigation requirements of 305,530 gallons per day at time of installation and the calculated evaporative losses from surface water storage ponds with a storage capacity totaling 6+ million gallons. Surface area of storage ponds total approximately 3.3 acres.

PROPOSED CHANGES. There are no proposed changes for the project renewal at this time.
