Project Facility Description

Site/Facility Name: York Building Products Co., Inc. – Bonnybrook Quarry

The York Building Products (YBP) Bonnybrook Quarry facility, formally Union Quarries. YBP acquired the site September 9, 2022, and is anticipated to be the long-term owner and operator. The facility operates a limestone quarry with a sump that provides water used in the processing of limestone aggregate, as well as serves to dewater the quarry pit.

All water withdrawn from the Quarry Sump is pumped to Direct Discharge or to a transfer pond. From the Transfer Pond, water is pumped to discharge or is consumptively used. Consumptive use water will be used for three activities at the facility: site dust suppression (roads), plant dust suppression, and incorporation into product. From Consent Order signed June 7, 2024, Quarry sump withdrawal limit of 3.165 MGD based on a consecutive 30-day average and consumptive use limit of 0.090 MGD based on a consecutive 30-day average have been set. YBP proposes to maintain the consumptive use limit and has had discussion with the Commission regarding further evaluation of the imposed withdrawal limit via email correspondence and guidance to continue monitoring, dated July 30, 2024.

The facility operates under existing Noncoal Surface Mining Permit No. 6476SM6 and NPDES Permit No. PA0595365. The permit encompasses 278.49 acres of affected land with 263.61 approved for active mining. The current operating bottom elevation is 355' MSL in the Phase 1 mining area, and the water table (~420' MSL) in all other permitted areas. Permitted maximum allowable pit depth is 200'.
