Facility Description for SRBC Application

Knoebels Three Ponds, Inc. owns and operates an 18 Hole Golf Semi-Private Golf Course and a full service restaurant located at 954 State Route 487, Ralpho Township, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania (the Facility). The Facility withdraws water from the main pond located on hole #16 to supply water for the golf course irrigation system. When necessary the pond is replenished with water from Roaring Creek South Branch. The Facility also uses water from a fresh water well to supply the clubhouse and restaurant operation. There is a second well near the equipment maintenance shop that supplies non-potable water used to wash down the said equipment. Water is consumptively used at the Facility for irrigation, restaurant cooking and cleaning, restroom operations, and equipment washing. Consumptive use and water withdrawals at the Facility are highest during main golfing season, which occurs from May through October. During the golf off-season, daily consumptive use and water withdrawals are significantly less. The clubhouse restaurant is a year round operation.
