

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The York Haven Hydroelectric Project is a hydroelectric generating facility on the Susquehanna River located in Dauphin, Lancaster, and York Counties, in Pennsylvania. The proposed project modifications include the construction and operation of an inland nature like fishway (NLF) versus the in-river NLF previously required. The inland NLF will primarily be located on Three Mile Island, along the north end of the Main Dam. Given its proximity to the Main Dam, some modifications are necessary. Once constructed, the inland NLF will provide upstream and downstream fish passage for American shad, American eel, and other anadromous and resident fish species.
