## **Section 2.1 Project Description**

### **Church & Dwight Co., Inc. - Davies Facility Docket Renewal**

Church & Dwight Co, Inc – Davies Facility (Facility) is requesting to renew SRBC Docket No. 20090301.1, which authorized the consumptive use of up to 0.9999 mgd. The water is supplied by the York Water Company (PWSID 7670100) which withdraws from the south branch and east branch of Codorus Creek. The facility has been operational since July 2009.

The Facility manufactures liquid laundry detergents, cat litter, and gummy vitamins onsite. The water purchased from the York Water Company system is used for domestic water (bathrooms, showers, cafeteria, etc.), boilers, and manufacturing processes (production, quality control testing, and CIPs). In addition to the water supplied by the York Water Company, a portion of the stormwater that drains on site is collected, treated, and used for flushing of toilets. Sources of consumptive use are evaporation, incorporation into product, and wastewater hauled off site out of the basin. Due to no significant changes of the product, and the previously approved consumptive use increase for possible expansion in 2016, the Facility is requesting renewal of the previously approved consumptive use.
